James opened by saying there is never enough time to cover everything. James began by talking about the "Dark Ages" around his diagnosis. James referred to his diagnosis in 1999 of multi-infarct dementia.

James referred to his gradual "re-joining" of the human race whereby he went from talking to no one to talking to groups that were 100's strong.

James looked for support and could not find a group for people living with dementia. After futile searches he started his own support group/working group The Glasgow Dementia Working group.

James spoke of his role as one of the first people living with dementia to be included in conferences and meetings. A true pioneer in "Nothing About Us Without Us" James' work has paved the way for other people living with dementia to have a voice and a choice in the way that people with dementia were included.
